(these rules and regulations apply to all observing locations)

Rules and Regulations

- 1 No alcoholic beverages or intoxicants will be allowed on the property. Additionally, intoxicated persons will not be permitted on the property.
- 2 Because of the sensitivity of electronics, and optics, Ten Acre Observatory is a Non-Smoking Facility, and because of the ever present fire danger, no open flame devices are permitted.
- 3 No glass containers permitted in the viewing area.
- 4 Because it will be dark and the ground is uneven, the possibility of personal injury and the risk of damaging expensive equipment make it necessary to prohibit horseplay in the observing area.
- 5 If flashlights are needed, they must always be shielded (with your hand) and pointed at the ground when turned on.
- 6 ***Please Do not*** leave trash in the observing area.
- 7 For groups of teens (ages 13 - 18 yrs.), we recommend a chaperone to teen ratio of 1 : 8 - 10 young people. For ages 12 and under we request a 1 : 6 ratio.

Suggestions

- 1 Because some standing around may be involved, we recommend that you bring something to sit on (a lawn chair, camping stool, blanket, etc.)
- 2 Feel free to bring something to drink and snack on.
- 3 Binoculars are a good thing to bring.
- 4 Dress according to the weather.
- 5 Bug spray with DEET during the warmer months is advisable.
