We, the members of the Republican Liberty Caucus of Florida Executive Committee, received your undated letter on or about July 28, 2008. As Chairman I write to respond on behalf of our organization.

The Republican Liberty Caucus of Florida is an intra-party caucus which supports the basic Republican principles of limited government, individual rights and free markets. We were chartered as an affiliate of the National Republican Liberty Caucus in 1991, which at the time was headquartered in Tallahassee, Florida. We have been advised by counsel that Florida Statute §103.081 (2) exempts organizations using the name of a political party which have been in existence and organized on a statewide basis for a period of ten years. We are therefore in full compliance with the law.

Our members are running for public office and campaign volunteers under the GOP banner. More importantly, we are committed to furthering the Republican cause through working with the party to achieve Republican victories at all levels in November and beyond.
