- Example of trees provided: Live Oak, Sand Live Oak, Southern Magnolia, Red Maple, and Bald Cypress. (Subject to change).
- Trees available only to Orange County residents.
- No pre-registration or fee to participate; simply provide proof of Orange County residency, such as a driver's license, photo I.D., or utility bill at location of choice.
