

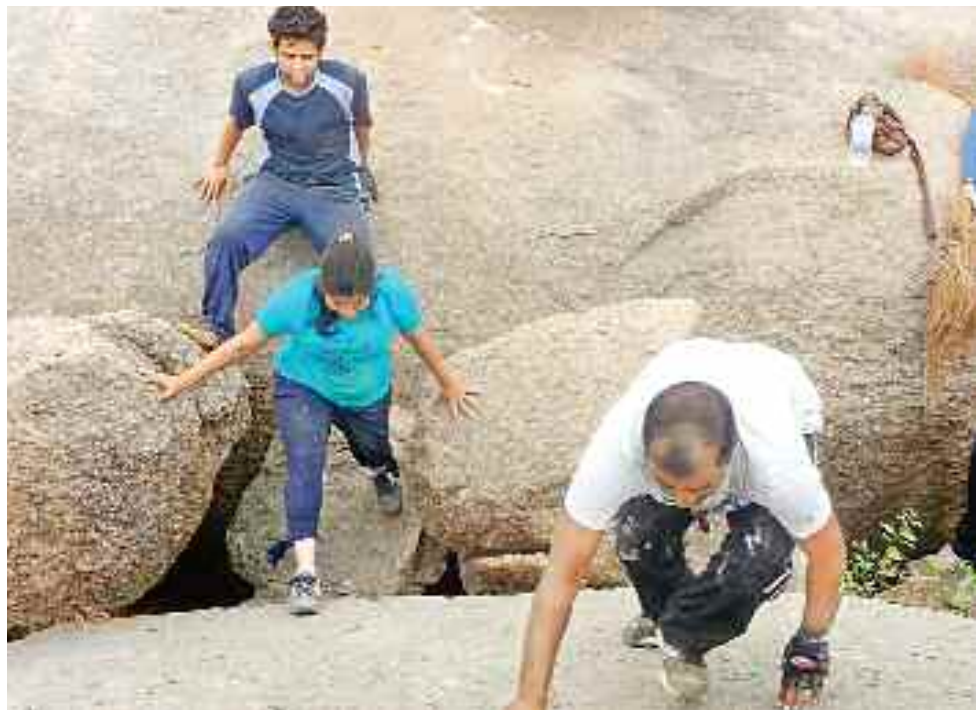
# Adventure Club has a great weekend plan
