

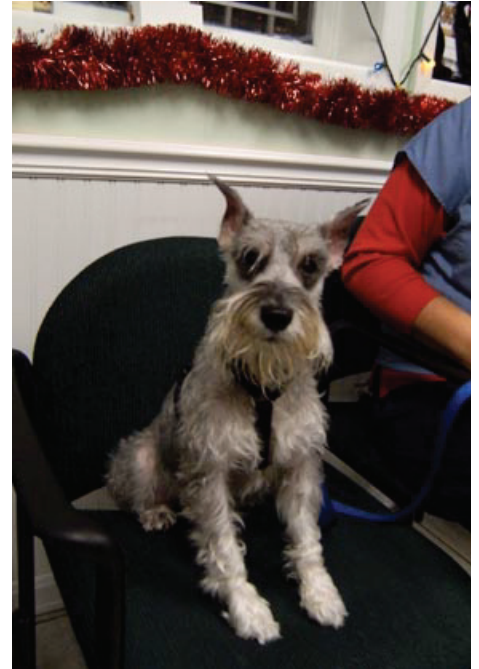
Tyler is Hoping for a Christmas Miracle
