**Message to PSCU Members from LISA THWING, Get-Out-the-Vote Chair, 32nd LD GOP:**

In the 32nd LD, we're fortunate to have five fine candidates-Rossi, Watkins, Baker, Coday, and Gagliardi. They need your help. The district is currently involved in Get Out The Vote. We have four pressing needs for volunteers.

**Doorbell**ing for all candidates-This is face to face contact with voters in the community and is the best way to ID our voters and to "sell" them our candidates. It's fun and easy—one of my favorite things to do. All doorbellers will be given literature and walking lists.

**Phoning** for all candidates-We can accomplish a lot of voter contact by telephone—great for non walkers and people who can do a bit here and there. All volunteers will be given calling lists and scripts.

**Literature drop**-We are looking for a number of volunteers to place literature on the doorsteps of a target precinct. The precinct may be your own. Get a little exercise and help our candidates at the same time. Volunteers will be provided with literature and a map of the area they'll cover.

**Ballot Chase**-This is done at the end of the election cycle and is how we get our own voters out. It's one of the most important things we'll do to help our candidates---we call our known voters who haven't yet turned in a ballot to remind them that every vote counts, and please turn in their ballot. All volunteers will be given a script and a call list.
