ISSUES

There are no state wide or full county issues this election.

All 5 ballots include these issues where applicable:

West Geauga School District has a vote for a 5.6 mill emergency renewal levy for 5 years.

Chagrin Falls School District has a vote for a 7.9 mill current and additional levy for CPT - meaning a Continuous Period of Time

Chardon Township has a vote for a 2.5 mill renewal levy for 3 years for fire service.
