## Program Descriptions

<p><b><u>Connecting with Families</u></b> Provides an opportunity for parents, caregivers and children to play, create and meet others from the community. We invite everyone to come to our circle time for a cooperative, sing-a-long, finger play and story time.</p> <p>(0-6 years) ♥</p>	<p><b><u>Connecting with Dads</u></b></p> <p>This program focuses on strengthening relationships between male family members and their children. The program will highlight ways to build language and make social / emotional connections. There will also be information sessions focusing on issues between fathers and children.</p> <p>(0-6 years) </p>	<p><b><u>Tiny Tots Time</u></b></p> <p>A program for children from the ages of newborn-2 1/2 years, offering developmentally appropriate activities including puzzles, matching games, sorting games, sensory games and more.</p> <p>(0-32 months) </p>
<p><b><u>D.E.A.R.</u></b> Drop Everything And Read time. Gives parents, and caregivers an opportunity to spend time reading a book with their child.</p>	<p>(✓) <b><u>Parent-Child Mother Goose (PCMG)</u></b></p> <p>A 10 week ongoing teaching session directed to parents, while their infants join in. Parents will gain skills by focusing on the pleasure and empowerment of rhymes, songs and stories. Each session involves a story told to parents giving them the same pleasure in language and listening which they in turn give to their children.</p> <p>(0-18 months) </p>	<p><b><u>Toy/Book Lending Library</u></b></p> <p>Parents and caregivers can borrow resource books and children can borrow a developmentally appropriate toy or book for the week. Available on a daily basis </p> <p>(✓) <b><u>Post Natal Yoga</u></b></p> <p>This class is designed to build relationships with newborns and their parents or caregivers. Poses will involve babies being lifted, gentle standing poses, stretches and twists. The class will run for 3 sessions.</p> <p>(0-6 months) </p>
<p>(✓) <b><u>Family Math</u></b></p> <p>A six- week continuous program for parents and caregivers of school-aged children from JK to grade one. The focus of the program is to build a positive attitude towards math. Participants will be introduced to games and activities that reinforce skills and develop math concepts, as well as fostering the enjoyment of math.</p> <p>(3 -6 years) </p>
