MS tracks are available in Biomedical Device Design and Entrepreneurship (with internships at local medical device companies), Clinical Imaging (with internships at clinical imaging labs), and Basic Research.

An accelerated (1-year) Dual Degree MS program provides opportunities for motivated students to earn dual Master's degrees.
