## *Covered Bridges*

### **Barronvale Bridge**

Near Rockwood, PA

The Barronvale Bridge was built in 1830 across Laurel Hill Creek using king post construction with arches added in 1906.

### **Burkholder Bridge**

Near Garrett, PA

Burkholder Bridge or Beechdale Bridge was built in 1870 to cross Coxes Creek. It uses burr arch construction.

### **Glessner Bridge**

Near Shanksville, PA

Glessner Bridge was built in 1881, crosses Stonycreek and was built with multiple king post construction.

### **King's Bridge**

Near New Centerville, PA

King's Bridge was built in 1806 across Laurel Hill Creek and used burr arch construction.

### **Lower Humbert Bridge**

Near Ursina, PA

Lower Humbert Bridge, built in 1891, crosses Laurel Hill Creek and is a burr arch structure.

### **New Baltimore Bridge**

New Baltimore, PA

New Baltimore Bridge crosses the Juniata River and was built in 1879 with queen post construction.

### **Packsaddle Bridge**

Near Glen Savage, PA

Packsaddle or Doc Mill Bridge was built in 1870, spans Brush Creek, and features multiple post construction.

### **Shaffer Bridge**

Near Johnstown, PA

Shaffer Bridge was built in 1877, crosses Ben's Creek and is of burr arch construction.

### **Trostletown Bridge**

Near Stoystown, PA

Trostletown Bridge was built in 1845, spans Stonycreek and is of queen post and king post construction.

## **Natural wonders and attractions**

### **Waterfalls**

**Cascades:** This beautiful woodland waterfall in Meadow Run is near the park office. The cool, clean waters of this stream make it a favorite haunt of anglers.

**Cucumber Falls:** This 30-foot bridal veil waterfall on Cucumber Run is easily reached from Meadow Run Trail and has parking on SR 2019.

**Jonathan Run Falls:** Several small waterfalls can be seen from Jonathan Run Trail. The largest waterfall tumbles over rocks between rhododendron-lined banks just before the trail meets the Youghiogheny River Trail.

**Meadow Run Waterslides:** The cascading beauty of this unique geologic formation attracts photographers, geologists and recreation enthusiasts. Explore Meadow Run's ancient streambed to find ripples carved in stone and potholes scoured by spinning rocks and powerful currents.

**Ohiopyle Falls:** The power and beauty of this 20-foot waterfall make it a central attraction to the park. The best viewing is from the observation deck in the Falls Day Use Area, in the heart of Ohiopyle.

**Mount Davis** is the highest mountain in Pennsylvania, although you certainly wouldn't know it if you paid it a visit. Mount Davis is the summit of 30-mile long Negro Mountain, and roads take you very near the summit. Several hiking trails encircle the highpoint, but none dip below 3,000 feet, meaning the mountain has little prominence from any vantage point. Views from the top are nice, especially with the very tall observation tower, that allows for expansive views in all directions. You are surrounded by mountains, and you can also see modern wind turbines on a nearby ridge.
