This is a **part-time position** with a **two-year commitment**.

#### **We are looking for parents who:**

- Can attend 15 meetings a year (including a minimum of 5 weekend trainings between March and May and monthly meetings from June through December)
- Can participate 20 hours outside of scheduled meetings, including advocacy activities
- Preferably bilingual in English and one of the following: Bengali, Chinese, Hindi, Korean, Punjabi, Tagalog, Urdu, and Vietnamese
- Available to meet on weekday evenings and/or weekends
- Wants to increase advocacy and leadership skills
- Have at least one child enrolled in an NYC public school (who is not currently a senior in high school) and/or have direct and recent experience with the public school system
- Able to make a 2-year commitment to the project

\*Meetings will mostly be in English. We encourage parents with limited English-skills to apply.
