

Potato Chip Scarf

A great word-of-mouth pattern for a light scarf perfect for adding a dash of excitement to your look. We call it the *Potato Chip Scarf* because you can't have just one! The design allows for easy yarn substitutions and the instructions are simple. This scarf in *Shine* and *Shine Twist* has a light summery feel. Knit in *Ambrosia*, it is a luxurious ruffle.

Note: If you want to use other yarns, knit with a needle that is at least two sizes larger than what is recommended for that particular yarn.

(A) Single Ruffle in *Twist*

Directions:

Cast on 90 sts

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Knit into front and back of every stitch

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Knit into front and back of every stitch

Row 5: Knit

Row 6: Knit into front and back of every stitch

Row 7: Knit

Bind off (Finished scarves are approximately 58" long)

(B) Double Ruffle in *Shine* and *Shine Twist*

Directions:

Following directions for (A), use a provisional cast on and knit one side with *Shine Twist*. Pick up the cast on stitches and knit half of the other half with first coordinating color and the second half with the other.



Finished Size:

Approximately 58" long.

Yarn:

(A) Knit Picks *Twist* (30% Cotton, 30% Viscose, 20% Acrylic, 20% Nylon; 99 yds/50 grams): Cotton Candy 23595, 2 balls.

(B) Knit Picks *Shine Twist* (60% Pima Cotton, 40% Modal®; 110 yds/50 grams): Seaside 23623, 2 balls
and

Knit Picks *Shine* (60% Pima Cotton, 40% Modal®; 110 yds/50 grams): Green Apple 23619 & Apricot 23612, 1 ball each.

(C) Knit Picks *Ambrosia* (80% Baby Alpaca, 20% Cashmere; 110 yds/50 grams): Mulled Wine 23740, 2 balls.

Needles:

Size 8: Circular, 32"



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(C) Single Ruffle in *Ambrosia*

Directions:

Cast on 180 sts

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Knit into front and back of every stitch

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Knit into front and back of every stitch

Row 5: Knit

Row 6: Knit into front and back of every stitch

Row 7: Knit

Bind off (Finished scarves are approximately 58" long).
