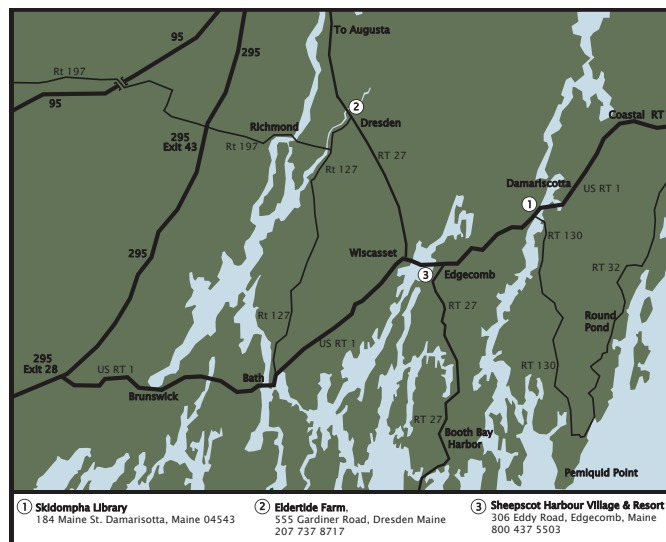
Day 1: October 17 2009
