Give way to others at all times.</li><li>2. Warn others of your approach.</li><li>3. Watch out for hazards.</li><li>4. Get off and walk if the path becomes difficult.</li><li>5. Ride in single file and don't bunch.</li><li>6. Don't risk a skid!</li><li>7. Only cycle in daylight.</li><li>8. Never race!</li><li>9.
