Cleats 4 Kids Program - The Kicking 4 Celiac Foundation's "Cleats 4 Kids" program collects sports cleats for both boys and girls and donates them to recreation centers and organizations in need, throughout the country. Currently in it's early stages, we have partnered this program with various organizations in underserved areas of New York and Los Angeles. This program was developed to give children in underprivileged areas the opportunity to play sports without the concern of being able to afford proper footwear. The Foundation collects cleats, new and used, not torn, and packs and ships them out to these areas. The purpose of this is to keep these children active, and to help them continue to live an enjoyable, happy, and healthy lifestyle.
