Rumsfeld, and former Attorney General Alberto Gonzales, accusing them of committing twenty specific violations and subversions of the U.S. Constitution.

Paul Craig Roberts: Impeach Bush and Cheney Now to Save America

Paul Craig Roberts, Assistant Secretary of the Treasury in the Reagan administration, Associate Editor of the Wall Street Journal editorial page, and Contributing Editor of National Review, writes:

The Democrats could easily impeach both Bush and Dick Cheney in the House, as impeachment only requires a majority vote. They could not convict in the Senate without Republican support, as conviction requires ratification by two-thirds of senators present.
