PAINTING WITHOUT PLANNING – THE SEQUEL: Don't be intimidated by the idea of painting! Come learn how to add the beauty of paint to your scrapbooks, cards, and altered art projects in this workshop with Carol Owen. She'll show you multiple techniques for creating beautiful designs using non-traditional tools, ranging from old credit cards to metal ribbon. If you took her previous workshop, Carol has developed some new techniques so you will definitely enjoy this sequel. If you've never tried a class with Carol, this is a wonderful introduction. At the end of class, students will use papers that they designed to construct a simple book.

PERFECT YOUR PHOTOS: Have a new digital camera? Or don't know how to use your traditional camera? Let us show you how to get the most out of it! The weakest link on a scrapbook page is often the photos, but it's easy to avoid the most common mistakes. First, we'll discuss what you can do to improve "point-and-shoot" shots, including tips for composition, lighting and avoiding red-eye. Then we'll focus on how to improve shots by using a camera's manual controls (whether your camera is digital or not).

SCRAPBOOK DESIGN & YOU

Our 10-course SDU program teaches scrapbooking fundamentals. Students receive materials explaining design elements of scrapbooking and create sample projects to master techniques. Classes are 1 hour and 15 minutes, except for Punches, which is 2 hours.
