The CAP Recipe to Save Canada From a North American Union
Police State

CAP Would Immediately:

1. Cancel the SPP
2. End all participation in the North American Union
3. Withdraw from the Bi-National Planning Agreement
4. Dissolve the North American Competitiveness Council,
5. Give the six month's notice and Abrogate NAFTA (NAFTA was the first step of the NAU and must be cut off. NAFTA is not about trade. NAFTA is about globalization. There is nothing in NAFTA to renegotiate)
6. Cancel all taxpayer funding for the working groups.
7. Cancel all taxpayer funding for the Super NAFTA corridors into Canada.
8. Restore independent Canadian military and police.
9. Disarm the Canadian border guards.
10. Eliminate Canada's No Fly list.
11. End the Canadian airport security rules against shampoos and nail files etc
12. End the sharing of airline passenger lists to foreign entities.
13. Ban the practice of biometric identifiers for employees at airports and elsewhere

14. Halt the Canadian introduction of Real ID cards, ie, biometric identifiers in passports and driver's licences.
