**David Joel Horowitz**, a conservative writer and activist was born January 10, 1939. The son of two life-long members of the Communist Party, and a former supporter of Marxism as well as a former member of the New Left in the 1960s, Horowitz later renounced his "left-wing political radicalism" and became an advocate for conservatism.

He is a founder of the [David Horowitz Freedom Center](#) (formerly the Center for the Study of Popular Culture), and has served as president of that organization for many years. He is the editor of the conservative website [FrontPage Magazine](#), and his writings can be read on news sites and publications.

He founded the activist group [Students for Academic Freedom](#), a public advocacy group that wrote the Academic Bill of Rights. (ABOR)

Horowitz has chronicled the radicalization of the American university and the way indoctrination has replaced education in four books:

1. *Uncivil Wars* (2003)
2. *The Professors: the 101 Most Dangerous Academics in America* (2006)
3. *Indoctrination U.* (2008)
4. *One Party Classroom* (2009)
