### **Measure 26-94 – NO**

Another property tax. Benefits The Children's Investment Fund for "proven early childhood programs, child abuse prevention and intervention, programs targeted at foster children, and after school, summer and mentoring programs for children". Need we say more?

### **Measure 54 – NO**

Amends Constitution to lower age to 18 years to vote in School Board Elections. It also says voters must be taxpayers. After 13 years of indoctrination in the system we give graduates the vote on the School Board. Wise idea??

### **Measure 55 – NO**

After the census, this measure changes the effective date of reapportionment of districts from Sep 15 and Dec 15 to the second Monday in January. Enables legislators to pass legislation over the holidays before redistricting is enacted.

### **Measure 56 – NO**

Destroys "double majority" requirement when legislature wants to tax us more. Double majority requires 50% of registered voters to cast ballots and a majority of voters to approve property-tax measures (like Measure 26-94 above).

### **Measure 57 – NO**

Increases minimum sentences for certain drug and theft crimes and mandates "treatment" without specifying what that might be. So we lock up drug addicts for a longer period of time in a facility where getting drugs is very easy. Hmmm.

### **Measure 58 - YES**

Encourages English emersion programs in schools and bi-lingual education to be taught for a maximum of 2 years enrollment.
