

Issues	Ron Paul	Mike Huckabee
Position on War	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —strongly believes in defending this country, not the world or United Nations proposals —believes that the US does not have the right to force our system on other independent nations and that doing so has spawned much of the anti-American sentiment abroad 	wants to continue and expand the war
Position on the UN & similar organizations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —wants to end US involvement with the UN —believes in free trade with all nations, but not trade deals that conflict with US sovereignty 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —as governor approved introducing an international curriculum that teaches UN ideology to 5 AR public schools —is in favor of globalization <i>done right</i>
Marriage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —states “government did not create the institution of marriage” and believes the federal gov. has no business interfering with something it has no constitutional power to regulate —supports the Defense of Marriage Act, which prevents states from accepting other states marriage laws and unions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —supports a federal constitutional amendment that defines marriage as a union between one man and one woman —led the successful effort to pass a state constitutional amendment defining traditional marriage —supports the Defense of Marriage Act
Personal Ethics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —declined to attend junkets or register for a Congressional pension while serving ten terms, —votes against appropriating taxpayer’s money for unnecessary expenses —never voted to raise Congressional pay 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —depleted the state emergency relief fund of \$500,000 for expenditures such as replacing the hard drives of computers in his office that his chief of staff ordered crushed before he left office; \$100,000 of this fund was spent in support of an Arkansas music band; \$97, 000 went to the Game and Fish Commission’s “Hooked on Fishing, Not Drugs” program; and more monies were spent on non-emergency relief—see link —Arkansas’ Ethics Commission has admonished Huckabee for violations five times in 14 years, and had 9 other complaints. —has accepted \$100,000’s in personal gifts while governor, some of which have appeared to be bribes
War on Drugs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —believes the War on Drugs is largely a waste of money, it has done nothing stop or slow illegal drug use; creates resentment in other nations that we involve fighting this war —opposes federal drug raids, believes state law should have jurisdiction in the matter. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —supports federal drug raids and continuing to fight illegal drugs —as governor believed people were punished too harshly for drug use, believed better solutions could be found for people suffering from drug and alcohol addiction
Position on the Constitution	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —has never voted to increase the power of the executive branch —believes in individual rights and freedom from federal bureaucrats passing invasive laws —very strong advocate for right to bear arms —a strong constitutionalist, believes in our Founders principals of limited government 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> —said that he would go to war <i>without Congress’s permission</i> “in a heartbeat” and defy Congress if it’s what he believes is “best for the American people,” directly opposing the Constitution —believes the President should have the line-item veto, an idea and legislation ruled un-constitutional by the Supreme Court
