INFECTIOUS DISEASES FROM H1N1 VACCINE?

The Age - LEADING infectious disease experts have called on the Federal Government to abandon its mass swine-flu vaccination plan because of fears the vaccine is a contamination risk that could spread blood-borne diseases.

Health Minister Nicola Roxon yesterday announced that the Government would start deploying its first batch of swine-flu vaccine in coming weeks, with an aim to vaccinate as many people as possible to prevent further spread of the virus.

But in a letter sent to Commonwealth Chief Medical Officer Jim Bishop, the Australasian Society for Infectious Diseases expresses deep concern about CSL's use of multi-dose vials for the vaccine and urged the Government to abandon its plan until it had single-dose vials.

Ms Roxon said it would be the biggest vaccination program in the shortest period of time that Australia has undertaken.

Meanwhile, nurses and doctors in the U.K. and the U.S.A. have refused to take the vaccine. They claim that the vaccine has undergone inadequate testing, and therefore too early to see if there are many side-effects.

'No credible evidence' of Iranian nuclear weapons, says UN inspector.

Guardian.co.uk - The UN's chief weapons inspector, Mohamed ElBaradei, said today he had seen "no credible evidence" that Iran is developing nuclear weapons, rejecting British intelligence allegations that a weapons programme has been going on for at least four years.

The claims and counter-claims came on the eve of a potentially decisive meeting in Geneva between diplomats from six world powers and an Iranian delegation about Tehran's nuclear ambitions.

ADA wants to send 2,000 more Australian troops to Afghanistan!

News.com.au - AUSTRALIA should replace the Netherlands as senior coalition partner in Oruzgan province when Dutch forces leave in August next year, the Australia Defence Association says.

That would require up to 2000 more troops, on top of 1500 already in Afghanistan, including combat support units assets such as artillery and attack helicopters.
