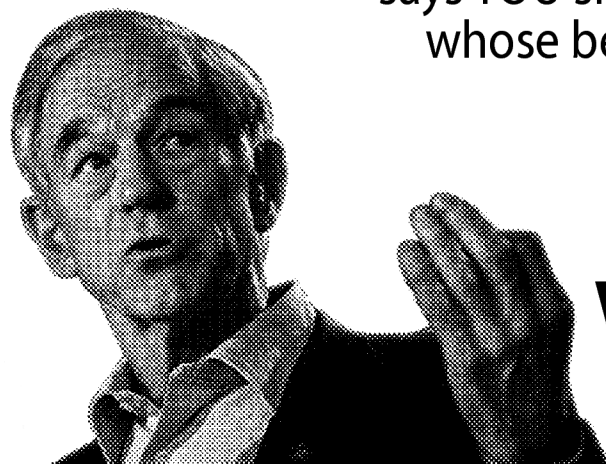
Why NJ Democrats and Independents should support Ron Paul for President:
