Acknowledgement of Rules for the 2008 Republican National Convention

The Kansas Republican Party has adopted the following rules relating to the 2008 Republican National Convention. Each delegate or alternate delegate is expected to abide by such rules.

1. At the Republican National Convention, each of the three district level delegates are required to vote for the winner of their congressional district caucus during the first round of balloting unless otherwise released by said winner.
2. At the Republican National Convention, all at-large elected delegates are required to vote for the winner of the overall statewide caucus during the first round of balloting unless otherwise released by said winner.
3. At the Republican National Convention, all delegates and alternate delegates are required to cover their own expenses.
4. At the Republican National Convention, all delegates and alternate delegates are expected to participate in the entire proceedings and all related activities before and after the proceedings.
