

Issues brought up from week 1 that have been resolved:

1. Looking for other San Diego Mike Huckabee group – currently, the official campaign is directing all San Diego residents to the meetup website. There are no other Huckabee groups in the area.
2. Link to the official campaign – the official campaign does not have plans of moving to California until after Super Tuesday (Feb. 5). As for now, we need to communicate through meetup.com
3. Can or will the San Diego County Republican Party help in any way with the Huckabee Campaign? We were not able to get in contact with the county offices but the general consensus was that they would not help. Instead, we are going to focus on building a strong foundation of Christian supporters by sending letters to ask for endorsements for Mike Huckabee, e-mail all of our family/friends, ...
4. Reaching out to college Republican groups to get more support for Mike Huckabee – we have members who are contacting various college groups (UCSD, SDSU, Pt. Loma Nazarene,...)

Protocol for event planning

Event planning is open to anyone, simply follow the following protocol:

- i. Let Eric (assistant organizer) know about the event so it can be posted on meetup
- ii. Have all the event details planned at least 1 week in advance (the meetup will not be posted unless notified at least 1 week in advance)
- iii. Event details include: Location/time/desired number of people to attend (goals for the event, be as specific as possible)
- iv. At least 1 person who can also attend the following meeting

Gameplanning

Ideas/plans that are taking place:

1. Yahoo Discussion Group – campaigning is now moving towards the internet and a discussion group is the perfect venue to spread beliefs in Mike Huckabee doubts and undecided voters. It is also a good area to strengthen our knowledge and reasons for believing in
2. Looking for support for college republicans
3. Future “town hall” type event to answer questions on Mike Huckabee – taking place in February

Ideas/plans that need participants

1. Looking up local leaders to ask for endorsement followed by sending out letters and making phone calls to look for support.
2. Putting up posters around the area

3. In a “town hall” type setting answer questions regarding the stances of Mike Huckabee – this also requires extensive studying on the ideas of Mike Huckabee.
4. We cannot fundraise since we are not the official campaign but once the official campaign settles in California, we would like to provide the foundations of a fundraising campaign to them. This role would require searching potential fundraising venue (determining price of the venue, how to book, maximum capacity,... as many details as possible).
5. Making/buying buttons for the entire group
6. Research on determining location/time of local polling
7. Door-to-door talks
8. Information tables

As stated before, anyone can help participate and lead an event and ideas are not restricted to those stated above. Contact the assistant organizer, Eric, to get something started or contact those who are already organizing.

Goals for each individual:

1. Mention Mike Huckabee to as many people as possible – contact AT LEAST 10 people per week.
