S.E.E.D Social Skills Therapy Group will address topics such as: Friendship Skills; Dealing With Feelings; Alternatives To Aggression; Classroom Survival Skills and more! There is no charge for this group.

Groups will be organized by age appropriateness/maturity Ages 4-9, 10-14, 15-18 and will run according to age at different times during the year.

P.E.A.C.E. (Parents Embracing Autism through Camaraderie and Education) Support Group is provided while the social skills therapy group is conducted with topics such as: Providing Structure; Recognizing and Supporting Child/Adolescent's Sensitivities/Triggers; Developing Child's Strengths & Self Esteem; Sibling Support and Family Stress Management. Parent group participants are limited to 2 caregivers per child. There is no charge for the parent group. No child care is available.
