

**RESOLUTION NO.: 53--2009-10**

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

MAJORITY

The Outagamie County Board of Supervisors recognizes that during economic recessions it is unwise for elected officials to increase the tax burden on its' citizens. Therefore, the Board of Supervisors does hereby find it advantageous at this time to establish a moratorium on enacting a County sales tax. This moratorium will encourage local economic growth and responsibly keep the focus on prioritizing reductions in the County's budget. Property owners are prioritizing their spending and County Government should reflect the reality of the citizens that it serves.

NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors recommend adoption of the following resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does hereby place a moratorium on the enactment of any size sales tax until the 2015 budget, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does recognize that situations do arise that may warrant an adjustment to this policy. Therefore, it will allow this policy to be set aside with a <sup>MAJORITY</sup> ~~three-fourths~~ vote of approval from the County Board, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Outagamie County Executive.

3 find it desirous at this time to establish a "Zero Increase" budget policy.

5 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors  
6 recommend adoption of the following resolution.

7 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does hereby enact a "Zero  
8 Increase" budget policy, which stipulates that the County will limit any spending increases to property  
9 tax revenues that are based solely on property improvements, ~~and that the levy rate would be adjusted~~  
10 ~~downward, to account for the inflation of assessed property, and.~~

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does recognize  
12 that situations do arise that may warrant an adjustment to this policy. Therefore, it will allow this policy  
13 to be set aside with a <sup>MAJORITY</sup> ~~two-thirds~~ vote of approval from the County Board, and

14 BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED that this policy would be in effect for the 2010 budget,  
15 and

16 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy  
17 of this resolution to the Outagamie County Executive.
