### **Items in No Particular Order**

- F27 Stryker Racing – racing has concluded until September.
- Paradise Field Report – the grass planted earlier this year did not take. General consensus was not to plant again next spring, but just to let what is there grow. Bob Green has sprayers, and will spot-spray larger weeds.
- Soar Paradise – reminder that this contest is July 11-12.
- NEFI (Aug 8-9) – about \$800 in prizes have been collected so far. Regarding the food for Saturday evening, there was a general desire to avoid less-than-stellar past dinners. The idea was proposed to move down the road to Spangle and have a no-host dinner at the (air-conditioned) Harvester restaurant & bar. Also, the hot dog vendor from last year will not be able to participate this year, so another vendor must be found. If anyone has ideas, please contact event director Dave Moore.
