

Wake LP business meeting notes, Nov 11, 2008

Location: Loco Lu's Coffeehouse Attendance: 7

Officer Reports

Chair – Fernie Williams reported that Munger had received the 2% threshold for the party to be on the ballot. He said he had received two DVDs from Tom Hohman for [The Libertarian Alternative](#). He mentioned the Raleigh Television Network classes, and Johnny Crawford said that the orientation workshop would be in December. (It's December 6. See the [note](#) on the Triangle Libertarian Meetup calendar for more information.) Fernie stated that 5 to 8 people would be needed in order to produce a show sustainably. Stephanie volunteered to do writing and editing for a possible show. Fernie also mentioned speaking about the Libertarian Party before a group of immigrants through a program of the Literacy Council of Wake County.

Vice-Chair – Joy Elliott talked about working with Johnny Shull on having Libertarian speakers at college campuses. As an elected Libertarian, Joy is a potential speaker.

Secretary – Linda Ellis mentioned adding a place on the agenda for EC members and directors to speak, and suggested this also for the weekly social meetings. She also mentioned that she had not completed the minutes for the previous month yet, due to misplacing her notes.

Treasurer – Stephanie Watson reported approximately \$30 in the account.

Old business

Business Meeting Schedule – Stephanie moved to have the business meetings on the second Tuesday of each month at Loco Lu's (or alternate venue.) Linda seconded. The motion passed without objection.

New Business

Wake LP Convention – Stephanie mentioned planning for the Wake LP convention. In further discussion, Joy mentioned that the LPNC Convention date is not yet set, and that we usually base the timing of our convention on that.
