*Ticket price increases to \$40 after May 7 and to \$45 after May 21. No ticket sales after May 24**

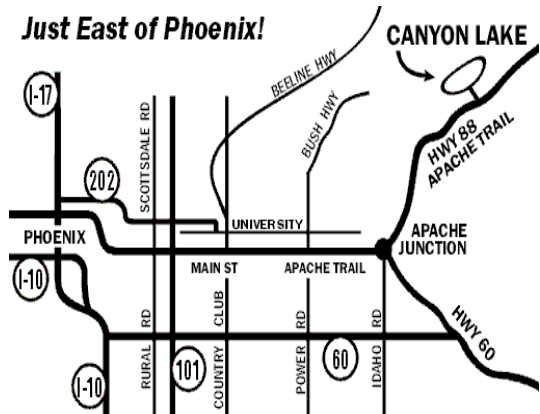

From the Idaho Road exit off the US 60 east, Canyon Lake is almost an hour drive north and east. Please plan your drive time to include that hour. Canyon Lake is a popular Memorial Day weekend attraction and traffic could be heavy. Highway 88 is a twisty, mountain road and is only two lanes; passing other vehicles can be a challenge. This is the Apache Trail and is a beautiful drive; so relax and enjoy the scenery. There is plenty of parking; however, you may not be able to park close to the marina where the Dolly Steamboat is located. Wear comfortable walking shoes and don't forget your sunscreen. Also, don't forget boarding is at 3:15pm—so plan your travel time accordingly. They will NOT hold the boat.

NOTE: Due to the mountain ranges, there is NO cell phone service once you are north of Apache Junction on Highway 88 or at Canyon Lake.
