INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HB 89</b>	<b>MILLER</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/FINANCE</b> Provides relative to the payment of accrued liabilities of retirement systems and other retirement obligations from minimum foundation program funds allocated to charter schools
<b>HB 101</b>	<b>EDWARDS</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHARTER</b> Requires charter school teachers to meet same certification requirements as other public school teachers
<b>HB 124</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHARTER</b> Provides relative to employment eligibility requirements for teachers in charter schools
<b>HB 125</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/ST SUPERINTDT</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the statewide election of the state superintendent of education
<b>HB 127</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/ST SUPERINTDT</b> Provides for election of the state superintendent of education
<b>HB 171</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES</b> Requires school boards and charter school governing authorities to offer to their employees the opportunity to participate in the La. Public Employees Deferred Compensation Plan
<b>HB 184</b>	<b>HAVARD</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHARTER</b> Provides relative to assets or property acquired or used by charter schools under certain circumstances
<b>HB 192</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHOICE</b> Provides relative to the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence (voucher) Program, including scholarship amounts, funding, and eligibility requirements for kindergarten students
<b>HB 276</b>	<b>GEYMANN</b>	<b>ELECTED OFFICIALS/STATEW</b> Makes the office of state superintendent of education an elective rather than an appointed office
<b>HB 701</b>	<b>EDWARDS</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHOICE</b> Provides relative to student eligibility for vouchers
<b>HB 702</b>	<b>EDWARDS</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHOICE</b> Provides relative to eligibility of kindergarten students for participation in the voucher program

<b>HB 703</b>	<b>EDWARDS</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHARTER</b> Prohibits the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education from authorizing charter schools under certain circumstances
<b>HB 836</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHOICE</b> Requires the state Dept. of Education to develop an accountability system for nonpublic schools participating in the voucher program and requires compliance with the system by such schools
<b>HB 954</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>EDUCATION/PRE-K</b> Provides relative to the Cecil J. Picard LA 4 Early Childhood Program
<b>HB 988</b>	<b>SCHRODER</b>	<b>STUDENT/STANDARDS</b> Permits local school boards to develop and implement curriculum content and methodology in lieu of that recommended by the state Dept. of Education or the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education
<b>HB 999</b>	<b>WILLIAMS, A</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHARTER</b> Limits the percentage of its funding that a charter school may use to pay certain management fees
<b>HB 1000</b>	<b>TALBOT</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHOICE</b> Provides relative to student eligibility requirements for the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence (voucher) Program
<b>HB 1208</b>	<b>PIERRE</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHARTER</b> Requires that students attending a charter school be provided free transportation in certain parishes.
<b>HB 1228</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHARTER</b> Provides relative to a program for educating students with exceptionalities
