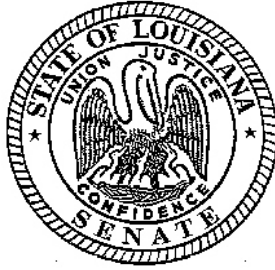

| SB 31 | BROWN, TROY | EDUCATION DEPARTMENT Requires DOE to report annually specified information regarding the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program to state legislators. (gov sig) |
| SB 36 | BROWN, TROY | SCHOOLS Requires notification to certain elected officials regarding submission and status of certain charter school applications. (gov sig) |

SB 56	NEVERS	POSTSECONDARY ED Requires secondary and postsecondary education boards to participate in regular meetings regarding articulation and transfer policies and agreements. (gov sig)
SB 81	BUFFINGTON	POSTSECONDARY ED Requires the boards of supervisors for the Louisiana State University, Southern University, University of Louisiana and Louisiana Community and Technical College systems to broadcast the live audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge over the Internet. (1/1/15)
SB 98	NEVERS	TOPS Provides that a five-point scale shall be used when calculating the grade point average for certain honors courses. (gov sig)
SB 125	NEVERS	EDUCATION DEPARTMENT Provides relative to agricultural education. (gov sig)
SB 126	NEVERS	TOPS Provides relative to TOPS-Tech Early Start award. (gov sig)
SB 177	APPEL	POSTSECONDARY ED Provides relative to the use, expenditure, or allocation of funds appropriated to public postsecondary education management boards. (gov sig)
SB 337	APPEL	POSTSECONDARY ED Provides for the development of an outcomes-based funding formula for postsecondary education. (gov sig)
SB 370	MORRELL	EDUCATION DEPARTMENT Provides for the documentation, notification, and reporting of incidents of bullying in schools, and provides for the training of certain school employees with respect to bullying. (8/1/14)
SB 379	LAFLEUR	SCHOOLS Provides relative to the size of secondary school classes. (8/1/14)

SB 449 APPEL

STUDENTS Provides relative to the privacy and protection of student data for students enrolled in public elementary, secondary, and postsecondary educational institutions. (gov sig)

SB 536 LAFLEUR

SCHOOLS Provides for K-12 student data privacy. (8/1/14)
