<b>SB 61</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY</b> Provides for the Louisiana Public School Choice Act. (gov sig)
<b>SB 162</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides with respect to ownership of assets by certain charter schools. (8/1/14)
<b>SB 179</b>	<b>MORRISH</b>	<b>EDUCATION DEPARTMENT</b> Provides with respect to the Course Choice Program. (gov sig)

<b>SB 191</b>	<b>MORRISH</b>	<b>EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY</b> Provides for equal recognition of International Baccalaureate, Advanced Placement, and dual enrollment courses. (gov sig)
<b>SB 225</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides relative to assets or property acquired or used by charter schools under certain circumstances. (gov sig)
<b>SB 533</b>	<b>LAFLEUR</b>	<b>EDUCATION DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for a local enrollment coordination process for publicly funded early childhood care and education. (gov sig)
<b>SB 558</b>	<b>LAFLEUR</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides relative to foreign language immersion programs in public schools. (7/1/14)
<b>SB 622</b>	<b>APPEL</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Requires the Department of Education to develop and implement a statewide educational technology plan for public elementary and secondary schools. (8/1/14)
<b>SB 633</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Prohibits certain schools from being a member of any interscholastic extra-curricular athletic association or organization that doesn't provide for third party arbitration of eligibility issues and requires certain schools to submit its budget for interscholastic extra-curricular athletics to the Department of Education. (gov sig)
<b>SB 636</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides relative to the organization and management of large school systems. (8/1/14)
<b>SB 666</b>	<b>CORTEZ</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Provides relative to charter school funding. (7/1/14)
