CURRICULA Requires instruction on sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention in public schools

- HB 988 SCHRODER STUDENT/STANDARDS** Permits public school governing authorities to develop and implement curriculum, content, and methodology in lieu of that recommended by the state Dept. of Education or the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education
- HB 1015 SCHRODER EDUCATION/SPECIAL** Provides for determinations for grade level promotion of certain students with exceptionalities regarding performance on state tests and provides for calculations of school performance scores relative to such students
- HB 1076 SCHRODER STUDENTS** Provides for limitations and prohibitions on the collection and sharing of student information and provides penalties for violations
- HB 1115 THOMPSON, J STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP** Provides relative to high school graduation requirements and core curriculum requirements with respect to the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS)
- HB 1129 THIERRY TEACHERS** Provides relative to professional development for teachers
