Make & bring lunch for families of patients near the end of life to allow them time to spend with their loved ones.

**KC Autism Training Center** *2nd Wednesday*  
Make and organize learning materials for the children with autism.

**Meals on Wheels** *1st Thursday*  
Decorate lunch bags with colorful artwork to uplift the elderly or sick unable to leave their homes.

**Micah Ministry** *4th Monday*  
Weekly Monday night meal serve to the poor and needy in a table-side manner by volunteers.

**Mother's Refuge** *2nd Thursday*  
Make & bring lunch for construction workers rebuilding the shelter for pregnant teens after it burnt down.

**Palestine Food Pantry** *Every 3rd Monday*

Clean and repair a former hospital being converted into a shelter with services for working homeless families.

**Serve KC** is a volunteer run group and always looking for dedicated volunteers with a passion for service to join our Leadership Team. Here are several ways you can get involved.
